



In the Matter of Assley, Hareley, Hawkesbury,  
and Inglestone Commons, Hawkesbury, Avon (No. 4)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 66 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 38 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 3, 21, and 68 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 21 July 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr V H Harris, solicitor, on behalf of Mr J W Blakeney, Mr D J Blakeney, and Mr J W Blakeney, junior, the applicants for the registration, and for Mr F E M Morton, the applicant for the conflicting registration at Entry No. 68. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the applicants for the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 3 and 21.

Mr Harris stated that he was instructed to agree that the description of the dominant tenement should be amended.

I therefore confirm the registration with the following modification; namely, the addition to the words in column 5 of the words "with the exclusion of O.S. number 849 on the O.S. map of the parish of Hawkesbury (1921 edition)".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
