



In the Matter of Assley, Hareley, Hawkesbury, and  
Inglestone Commons, Hawkesbury, Avon (No. 11)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 68 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 38 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 66, 67, and 69 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 21 July 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr V H Harris, solicitor, on behalf of Mr F E M Moreton, the applicant for the registration, Mr J W Blakeney, Mr D J Blakeney, and Mr J W Blakeney, junior, the applicants for the conflicting registration at Entry No. 66 (Mr J W Blakeney and Mr D J Blakeney being also the applicants for the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 67 and 69 respectively).

Mr Harris stated that he was instructed to agree that the registration should be confirmed.

I therefore confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
