In the Matter of Felton Hill or Felton Common, Winford, Avon (No.2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 31 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.9 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Somerset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 0/53 made by the late Mr W E G Rendal and Objection No. 0/70 made by the Rev. Prebendary H L Franklin and both noted in the Register on 20 August 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Weston-Super-Mare on 18 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P G Webb, the Chairman of the Winford Parish Council. The Objections relate solely to the inclusion of two small areas in the Register Unit. For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Felton Hill or Felton Common.Winford (No. 1) (1978), Ref. Nos 58-59 I have confirmed the registration in the Land Section of the Register Unit with the exclusion of the land the subject of Objection No. 0/70.

There being no objection to the registrations in the Rights Section of the Register Unit in so far as they relate to the land now comprised in the Register Unit. I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
