



In the Matter of Hinton Common, ~~Dyrham~~ and Hinton,  
Avon (No.2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.G/CL435 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. Ob. 156 made by Mr J R W Blathwayt and Objection No. Ob. 370 made by the Dyrham and Hinton Parish Council and both noted in the Register on 12 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 20 July 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr J D B Milner of Counsel, on behalf of Mr Blathwayt and the Dyrham and Hinton Parish Council was represented by Mrs S Rae, its Clerk. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mrs Mabel Higgins, and Mr V U R Higgins, the applicants for the registrations.

There being no evidence in support of the registrations, I refuse to confirm ~~in them~~

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
