

In the Matter of Land South of Rickford, Burrington, Avon (No. 2).

DIVISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 165 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Somerset County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos 0/169 and 0/170 both made by Sir John Wills, Bt and both noted in the Register on 17 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Weston-super-Mare on 18 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr M C Wilson, the Vice-Chairman of the Burrington Parish Council and Clerk to the Conservators of Burrington Common. Mr Wilson informed me that he was authorised also to express the views of the Objector.

Since, for the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Land South of Rickford, Burrington (No. 1) (1978), Ref. No. 260/D/55, I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit, it follows that I must refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
