



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Lyde Green Common, Puckleschurch,  
Avon (NO.1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.127 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 101 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 11 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 19 July 1983. The hearing was attended by Miss D Jenkins Evans, Solicitor, on behalf of the Avon County Council, the successor authority of the Objector. There was no appearance on behalf of the Pucklechurch Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

The grounds of the Objection was that a part of the land comprised in the Register Unit is not common land, but forms part of two county highways.

The land in question is shown as highway land on the definitive map of county highways maintained by the County Council.

There being no other evidence, I confirm the registration with the following modification namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of the objection.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
