COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



In the Matter of Pump Square, Pill, Easton-on-Cordano, Avon.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Mo. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit Mo. VG 99 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection Mo. 0/809 made by the former County Council and noted in the Register on 29 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Weston-super-Mare on 19 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr G W Duck, a member of the Paston-in-Gordano Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and Mr A James, solicitor, on behalf of the Avon County Council, the successor authority of the Objector.

The Objection relates to two areas which were formerly covered with buildings. In Duck stated that he did not wish to support the registration in so far as it related to these two areas.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification :- namely the exclusion of the two areas referred to in the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
