## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 48 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 190 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 687 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 27 February 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 21 July 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr V H Harris, Solicitor and Clerk to the Conservators of Sodbury Commons the applicants for the registration, and Miss D Jenkins-Evans of the Commons Registration Section of the Avon County Council.

The Objection is to the inclusion in the Register Unit of certain roads and paths identified by numbers and shown on an attached plan.

By my decision in <u>In the Matter of Sodbury Commons (No. 1</u>), (1981) Ref. No. 269/D/179 have confirmed the registration in the Land Section of the Register Unit with the exclusion of a number of the roads and paths the subject of the Objection.

It therefore only remains for me to confirm the registrations the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
