## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 51 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Somerset Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos 0/258 and 0/819 made by the former Bristol Corporation and noted in the Register on 20 April 1971 and 6 September 1972 respectively.

I held a hearing for the purpose on inquiring into the dispute at Weston-super-Mare on 17 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr M G Keen a member of the Easton-in-Gordano Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Bristol City Council, the successor authority of the Objector, and Mr Keen informed me that the City Council did not wish to pursue the Objections.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision of the High Court.
