



In the Matter of Three small plots of land,
Siston, Avon

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.457 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.693 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 6 December 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 3 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr A Hudson of the Legal Department of the Avon County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr J A S Williams, the applicant for the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration with the following modification: namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
