

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 260/D/42

In the Matter of Upper Town Green, Falton, Winford, Avon (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG.17 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.160 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Western Super Mare on 17 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P G Webb, the Chairman of the Winford Parish Council.

The two registrations are in conflict only to the extent that part of the land comprised in the registration consists of the land comprised in the conflicting registration. Mr Webb informed me that the Parish Council did not wish for that part of the land to be comprised in the registration.

There being no other appearance at the hearing, I confirm the registration with the the following modification namely, the exclusion of the land comprised in the conflicting registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Count.
