



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 260/D/43

In the Matter of Upper Town Green,  
Felton, Winford, Avon (No. 3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 160 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 17 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Weston-super-Mare on 17 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P G Webb, the Chairman of the Winford Parish Council.

Since I have refused in my decision in In the Matter of Upper Town Green, Felton, Winton (No 2) (1978), Reference No. 260/D/43 to confirm the conflicting registration in so far as it is in conflict with the registration, it only remains for me to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
