

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.1/D/8

In the Matter of Goldington Green, Goldington, Bedford Borough, Bedfordshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.V.G.10 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Bedfordshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.35 made by the Bedford Corporation and noted in the Register on 24 September 1970.

Frederick William Hart on whose application the said registration was made died on 1 August 1971 and probate of his will was on 18 October 1971 granted to Lloyds Bank Limited out of Ipswich District Probate Registry.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute including Lloyds Bank Limited have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, which terms are that the Commons Commissioner do confirm the registration as Village Green of the land within the green edging on the attached plan and do refuse to confirm the registration as Village Green of the remainder of the land in this Register Unit.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:— There shall be removed from the Register the part of the land comprised in this Register Unit which is not within the green edging on the plan attached to a document which is headed "Application for decision by Consent", which sets out the agreed terms of the decision to be given in this matter and which has been signed by or on behalf of the parties on 2, 11, 4 and 16 May 1973.
