



In the Matter of Snelsmore East Common,  
Chieveley and Shaw-cum-Donnington,  
Berkshire

DECISION

---

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 152 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Berkshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 46 made by Mr J S Fairhurst and Objection No 38 made by Mr G G Mattli and Mrs F Mattli and both noted in the Register on 4 January 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Newbury on 1 February 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr O S Child, solicitor, on behalf of Mr Fairhurst and by Mr J Marshall, solicitor, on behalf of Mr and Mrs Mattli. There was no appearance on behalf of the Newbury District Council, the successor authority of the former Newbury Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration.

There being no evidence in support of the registration I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
