

In the Matter of Coombe Hill, Ellesborough, Buckinghamshire (No.1).

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 275 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Buckinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 64 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 20 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Aylesbury on 27 June 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P R Fitzgerald, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr R E Coates, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of the Register Unit, pursuant to which this registration was made, but in a letter dated 9 June 1978, addressed to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners, Mr Coates's solicitors stated that he did not wish to pursue the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
