



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 3/7/29

In the Matter of Keep Hill, High  
Wycombe, Wycombe District.

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG.16 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Buckinghamshire Council and is occasioned by Objection No.16 made by High Wycombe Borough Council and noted in the Register on 16th October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Aylesbury on 16th October 1975.

The hearing was attended by Mr. D. S. Woods the Secretary of the High Wycombe Rye Protection Society and by Mr. Lloyd on behalf of Wycombe District Council.

This dispute came on for hearing immediately after the hearing of Reference No. 3/7/4 relating to the Rye. Mr Woods stated that he had no submissions to make in this case which he had not already made in the Rye case and accepted that if I refuse to confirm the Registration in the Rye case I must also refuse to confirm the Registration in this case.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
