



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Mill Wood, Wooburn,  
Wycombe District, Buckinghamshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 263 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Buckinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 103 made by Mr George James Pitcher and noted in the Register on 3 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Aylesbury on 9 March 1978. At the hearing (1) Wooburn Parish Council on whose application the registration was made were represented by Mr R Dukes solicitor of Allen James & Co, Solicitors of High Wycombe and (2) Mr G J Pitcher was represented by Mr T Clarke solicitor of Clarke & Son, Solicitors of High Wycombe.

Mr Dukes said that the Parish Council wished to withdraw. Accordingly I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
