



In the Matter of Northend Common, Turville,  
Buckinghamshire (No. 1)

DECISION

---

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 5 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Buckinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 74 made by Mr J C L Fane and noted in the Register on 21 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Aylesbury on 27 June 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P R Fitzgerald, solicitor, on behalf of Mrs P H Slater, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 3 in the Rights section of the Register Unit, by Mr J H Langford, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 2 in the Rights section, and Mr B J Vaughan, the son of Mr J D Vaughan, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 4 in the Rights section, and by Mr H H J Button, the Clerk of the Turville Parish Council, an objector to the registrations at Entry No 3 in the Rights section.

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Objector.

Mr Button agreed that the registration at Entry No. 3 should be confirmed.

In these circumstances I confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
