



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 3/D/17, 42 & 43

In the Matter of Tyler's Green
Common, Chepping Wycombe, Wycombe
District

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section and the deemed registration in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.CL.11 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Buckinghamshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No.49 made by Mr L. D. Hampton and noted in the Register of Unit No. VG.9 on 20th October 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG.9 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Aylesbury on 15th October 1975.

The Chepping Wycombe Parish Council appeared by Mr Crick Clerk to the Council and Mr Hampton appeared by Mr. Hulett of Messrs Winter Taylor Woodward and Webb.

Mr Leslie Downs who applied for the registration of the land in question as Common Land did not appear. There are no entries in the Rights Section of the Register.

In the absence of any evidence that the land is common land I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
