



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.204/D/6

In the Matter of Queen's Green,
Cambridge, Cambridgeshire (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No.CL 62 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.84 made by Dr J.M.Prentis on behalf of Queens' College, Cambridge, and noted in the Register on 7th August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cambridge on 22nd October 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr G.F.Taylor, solicitor, on behalf of the Cambridgeshire County Council, the registration having been made by the registration authority without application, Mr R.Hanton, solicitor, on behalf of the Cambridge City Council, and Mr J.Tiley, a fellow of Queens' College.

The Objection relates to only a half of the bed of the river on the eastern side of the land in question, and I was informed that the parties were agreed that this should not have been included in the Register Unit. I have therefore confirmed the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit with the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
