

COLMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 204/D/18

In the Matter of The Parish Pits, Morden Grange Plantation, Steeple Morden, Cambridgeshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL 21 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely County Council and is occasioned by Objections Nos.82 and 83 made by Bury Field Estates Ltd and Melbourn Whiting Company Ltd respectively and noted in the Register on 28th July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cambridge on 23rd October 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr J.S.Thompson, of counsel, on behalf of the Objectors. There was no appearance on behalf of the Steeple Morden Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

There being no evidence in support of the registration, I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
