In the Matter of Westside Common
Godmanchester, Hunts D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entries Nos 1 and 2 in the ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 15 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Huntingdon and Peterborough County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 48 made by W J N James and Objection No. 46 made by John Looker and both noted in the Register on 3 December 1970 and the conflicting registrations at Entries Nos 1 and 2 in the ownership section of the said Register.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring in to the dispute at Huntingdon on 28 June 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr Petty of Messrs Hurnyburn & Sons who appeared for the Freemen of Godmanchester and Mr Hough of Messrs Writers appeared on behalf of Huntingdon District Council. Mr Petty and Mr Hough agreed that both the Council and the Freemen were *beneficially* interested in the land in question and that I should therefore refuse to confirm the Entry at No. 1 in the ownership Section and confirm the Entry at No. 2 modified, by adding in column 3 the names:-

Henry John Mason }
Brian Stanley Reeve } As trustees for the Freemen of Godmanchester
John Eric Tiseland }

As joint owners with the Borough of Huntingdon and Godmanchester, and I do so accordingly. Mr James and Mr Locker did not appear.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
