



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Free Green,  
Over Peover, Peover Superior Parish,  
Macclesfield District, Cheshire

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Free Green, Over Peover, Peover Superior Parish, Macclesfield District being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL. 59 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cheshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Stockport on 29 October 1979. At the hearing Macclesfield Borough Council were represented by Mr R L Cole one of the Solicitors with the Council.

Mr Cole on behalf of the Council offered no evidence of ownership. The land he said is not included in the terrier of land owned by his Council. In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
