



In the Matter of Scotch Common, Sandbach,
Cheshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 17 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cheshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 21 made by the Trustees of the Crewe Unsettled Estate and noted in the Register on 23 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chester on 24 July 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr R H Flint Deputy Secretary of, and representing Congleton Borough Council.

The registration was made on the application of Sandbach UDC of which the Borough Council is the successor. The Objection was on the grounds that the Objectors own the freehold of the land.

The Borough Council has now acquired the interest of the Objectors in the land, and the latter are no longer interested to maintain the Objection. The Borough Council wish the registration to be confirmed and this I do.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
