



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 271/D/64

In the Matter of Blaen Llynor and
part of Moel yr Henfaes, Llandrillo,

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 189 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 259 made by the Merioneth Branch of the National Farmers Union and noted in the Register on 26 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 6 December 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Douglas Williams of the National Farmers Union who produced a consent signed by Alan Mattingley on behalf of the Ramblers' Association who registered the land as Common Land that I should refuse to confirm the registration.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
