



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Land adjoining
the Quarry, Graigfechan, Llanfair DC,

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 241 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 123 made by E N Hughes and noted in the Register on 13 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Mold on 12 May 1976. The hearing was attended by Messrs Geoffrey Morris & Ashton on behalf of Mr H E O Dyke who claimed to be the owner of the land in question. The Objector Mr E N Hughes did not appear. I was told that Mr Hughes had withdrawn his objection in 1972. In these circumstances I have no alternative but to treat the Entry in the Ownership Section as undisputed and I therefore confirm the Registration.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
