



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 51/D/21

In the Matter of Land at Castle Mill  
Cottages, Chirk

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the ownership section of Register Unit No. CL.107 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Clwyd County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 60 made by Mr John Rodney Jones and Mrs Ella Vaughan Jones and noted in the Register on 25th September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Ruthin on 4th April 1974. The hearing was attended by Mrs Restall (the applicant for registration) and by Mr R.M. Edwards Solicitor, of the firm of Messrs Longueville & Co., on behalf of the Objectors.

I refer to my decision under the reference No. 51/D/20, by which I refused to confirm the registration of this land as common land. It follows that the question of ownership does not arise.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
