



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.5L/D/3

In the Matter of Land at Fron Ucha ChirkDECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.C.L.26 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Denbighshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.69 made by Capt David F.Myddleton and noted in the Register on 29th September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Denbigh on 22 November 1972. The hearing was attended by Mr.J.Bentley of Messrs.Cyril Jones and Co,Solicitors, Wrexham, on behalf of the applicant, Chirk Parish Council, who requested that I should refuse to confirm the registration. There was also produced to me a letter dated 21st November 1972 from the objector's agents, Messrs.Cooke Leathes and Bickerton, to the Clerk to the Commons Commissioners, stating that they consented to the withdrawal of the registration.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
