



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Land at Moel Morfydd Mountain,  
Bryneglwys, Glyndwr

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 1 to 13 inclusive in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.73 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 39 made by Duncan Robertson and noted in the Register on 23 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 30 and 31 March and 1 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Sopwith on behalf of Mr Duncan Robertson and by all the applicants for Rights by their legal representatives or agents or in person. This small piece of land comprising only 1.8 acres adjoins Unit No. CL.21. It is manifest that it cannot sustain by itself more than 3 or 4 sheep and the convenient course is to permit the sheep grazed on CL.21 to graze on this land. I am further told by Mr Sopwith that only the applicants under Entries 1 and 12 in fact graze on this small parcel of land. For this reason I refuse to confirm the Entries at Nos. 2 to 11 inclusive and No. 13 and I confirm the Entries at Nos. 1 and 12 modified by deleting in each case all the words in column 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the right to graze over this Unit the sheep they are entitled to graze over Unit No. CL.21".

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
