



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Land at Mynydd Penybryn,
Llanfair D.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.212 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 95 made by A O and H V Jones and noted in the Register on 2 June 1971 and Objection No. 96 made by G Smith noted in the Register on 2 June 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Mold on 12 May 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Bourne of Messrs. Walker Smith and Way on behalf of the successor to Mrs Jones who registered a claim to rights as appertenant to Fawr Farm, Pentrecelyn and by Mr Wynn Jones on behalf of the objector Mr G Smith.

Mr Bourne stated that neither Mrs Jones nor his client her successor now claimed any rights over the land in question and the Entry in the Land Section being consequent upon the claim for rights that Entry can no longer be supported.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
