



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Land by River Ceiriog
near Dothiryd Bridge, Glyntraian,
Glyndwr D

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land by river Ceiriog near Dothiryd Bridge, Glyntraian, Glyndwr D being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 140 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference the National Trust claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Mold on 16 June 1977.

Mr T A G Sopwith appeared on behalf of The National Trust and produced a conveyance dated 29 September 1948 whereby the land in question, identified on a plan annexed thereto, was conveyed by C B C Storey to The National Trust.

On this evidence I am satisfied that The National Trust is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Clwyd County Council, as registration authority, to register The National Trust as the owner of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
