DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 206 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 180 made by J E Lightfoot and noted in the Register on 3 August 1972 and Objection No 181 made by L Davies and noted in the Register on 3 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Mold on 14 June 1977.

The hearing was attended by Mr I W Jones of Messrs Williams Jones & Talog Davies on behalf of the Objectors and by Mr S Williams of Messrs Stanley Williams & Co on behalf of Mr G O Davies the owner of Fron Farm Llandegla to which the rights claimed by Entry No 3 are appurtenant. In accordance with an agreement arrived at between the parties I confirm the Entry at No 3 modified so as to substitute in column 4 the words "30 sheep" in place of the words "one hundred".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
