



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 in the Land Section and No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL. 213 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 126 made by Mr M H Bird Jones and noted in the Register on 20 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 1 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Richards of Charles Richards & Sons on behalf of Mr Bond the applicant for Rights and Mr Parry counsel, instructed by Messrs Hopley Pierce & Bird on behalf of Mr Bird Jones. Mr Parry withdrew Mr Bird Jones' objection.

Mr Bond has rights to graze his flock over Units No. CL. 22, CL. 126, CL. 127 and CL. 128 as well as over this Unit and for this reason I confirm his Entry in the Rights Section modified by inserting after the words "comprised in this Register Unit" in the 4th column the words:-

"and Units Nos. CL. 22, CL. 126, CL. 127 and CL. 128 but so that the number of sheep grazed on this and the other said Units at any one time shall not exceed 294 ewes and followers".

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
