



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.206/D/47

In the Matter of Additional Piece of Land
at Greenberry Downs, Germoe, Cornwall (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos.1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 522 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.X 75 made by Mrs E.K.James and noted in the Register on 16th July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 12th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr B.H.Fox, solicitor, on behalf of Mr C.H.Banks and Mrs G.C.Banks, the applicants for the registrations. I was informed that the Objector was dead, but Mr Fox stated, however, that he was not asking for the registrations to be confirmed.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
