



In the Matter of An Additional Piece of
Land called Rosenannon Downs or Common,
St Wenn, Restormel B

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entries Nos. 2 and 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 224 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X965 made by Mr R A G Sims and Jean F Sims and noted in the Register on 4 April 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 16 October 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr C A Gillingham, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the successors to the respective applicants for registration at Entries Nos. 2 and 3. Mr Gillingham informed me that his clients withdrew their claims to the rights registered and accordingly I refuse to confirm the registrations.

Mr Gillingham also acts for the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section. His clients are willing that this entry should be cancelled, but since it has become final I do not have jurisdiction to deal with this matter. It may be possible to seek amendment of the Register by the Register^{ation} Authority under Section 13 of the 1965 Act and Regulation 29 of the General Regulations 1966.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
