



In the Matter of Boscoppa and Boscundle
Common, St. Austell, Cornwall

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 497 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X39A made by the former Cornwall County Council, and noted in the Register on 8 January 1973.


I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 25 ~~June~~ 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr E Pate, Solicitor, on behalf of the Restormel Borough Council, the successor authority of the former St. Austell with Fowey Borough Council, the applicant for the registration.

Mr Pate informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
