

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Boswens Moor (part), Madron
and Sancreed

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land above mentioned being part of the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 207 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mr John Thomas Trewern claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Camborne on 24 November 1982.

Mr W J Trewern appeared on behalf of his father, the claimant, and produced the latter's title deeds.

On this evidence I am satisfied that John Thomas Trewern is the owner of the land, and shall accordingly direct the Cornwall County Council, as registration authority, to register him as the owner of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
