



In the Matter of Bunnings Park, St Neot,
Cornwall (No 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 518 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No X 435 made by Viscount Clifden and noted in the Register on 18 May 1971 and Objection No X 152 made by Mr O Chambers and noted in the Register on 21 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 13 December 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr David Widdicombe, Q.C. on behalf of the Objectors. Mr P J Tyler, the applicant for the registration was not present and was not represented, but Mr Widdicombe produced a document dated 3 October 1977, which he proved to have been signed by Mr Tyler, requesting me to refuse to confirm the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
