



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.206/D/16 & 17

In the Matter of Carnkie Common
Wendron, Kerrier D, Cornwall

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No.1 in the Land Section and Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 239 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No.X1075 made by Mr W.S. Richards and noted in the Register on 12 September 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Truro on 9 May 1975.

The hearing was attended by Mr R.A. Bullough of Messrs G.L. Robins, Solicitors for Mr E.H. James and Mr Fox of Messrs Rogers & Son Solicitors for Mr Richards. Mr Gill on behalf of the Cornwall County Council stated that Mr Richards's objection had been registered in error on this register Unit No.CL239 instead of on Register Unit No.CL739 and neither he nor Mr Fox on behalf of Mr Richards raised any objections to these registrations.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations at Entry No.1 in the Land Section and at Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of the said Register.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
