



In the Matter of Gunwalloe Church Cove
(part), Gunwalloe

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land above mentioned being the part of the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 235 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Camborne on 19 January 1983.

No one appeared at the hearing.

Part of the land is registered under and as part of Title No. CL 8315.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the remainder of the land coloured purple on the map annexed hereto and it will therefore be subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.

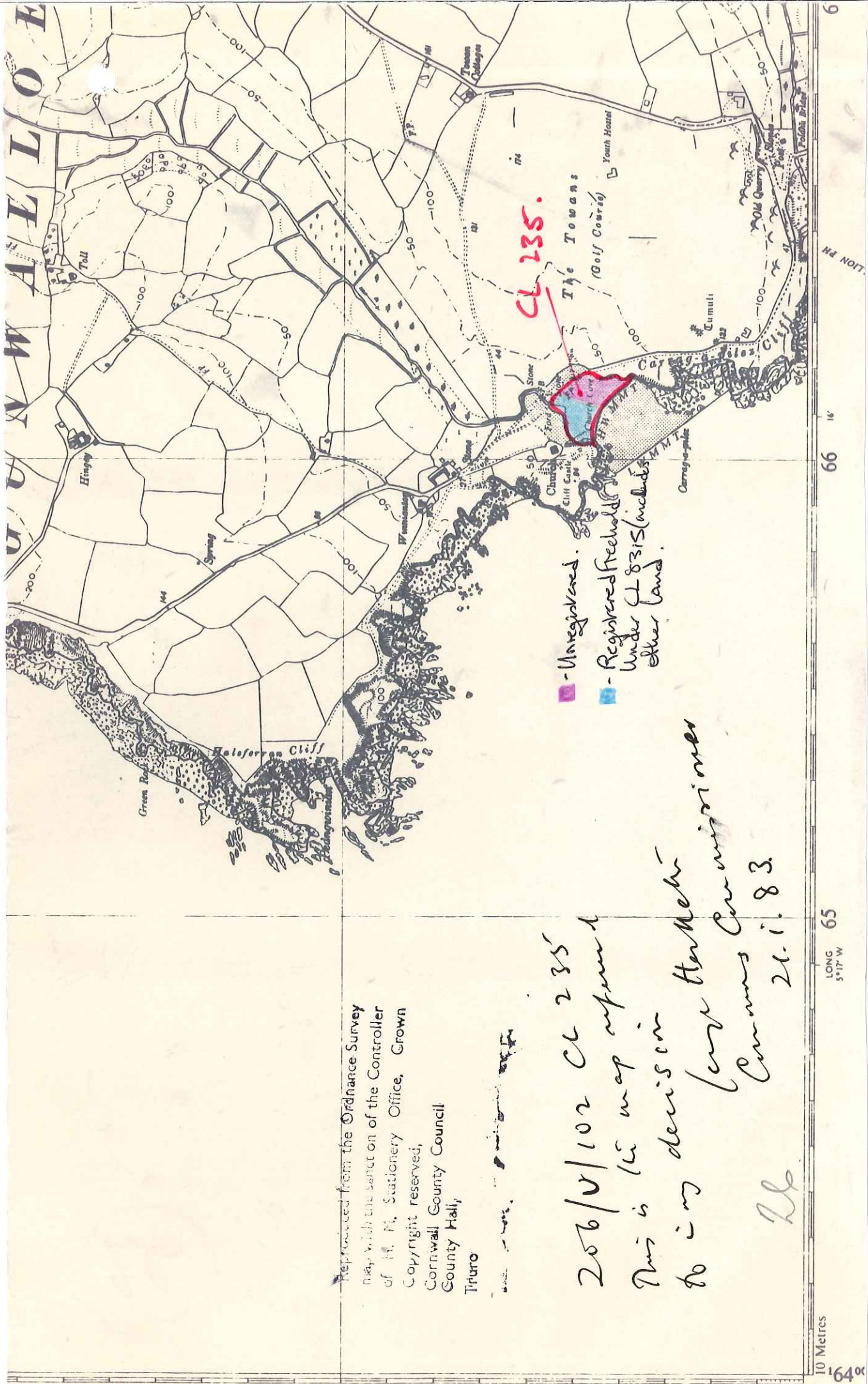
