



In the Matter of Dollar Cove, Gunwalloe,  
Cornwall (No. 1)

DECISION

---

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 234 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No X157A made by the former Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 16 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 15 December 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr E C Peters, solicitor, on behalf of Mr James Hocking, one of the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of the Register Unit, and Mr W H K Ferris, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 2 in the Rights section, and by Mr N Butterfield, of counsel, on behalf of the Objector.

During the course of their evidence, which related also to land comprised in other Register Units, Mr Hocking and Mr Ferris both stated that they withdrew their claims in respect of the land comprised in this Register Unit.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
