DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 159 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No X113 made by British Rail and noted in the Register on 30 July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 30 July 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Foulkes of Messrs Bond Pearce & Co on behalf of Mr Alford who at Entry No 1 of the Ownership Section claimed to be the owner of the whole of the land comprised in this Unit and Mr Woodroffe appeared for British Rail. Mr Foulkes accepted that his client was not the owner of the land the subject of British Rail's objection and that I should modify the Entry in the Ownership Section by excluding the land identified on the plan annexed to that Objection, and I therefore confirm that Entry modified as aforesaid.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
