In the Matter of Four Additional Pieces of Land known as Innis Downs, Luxulyan, Cornwall

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 630 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X61A made by the former Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 24 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 25 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D M Gill, the Commons Registration Officer of the County Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Ramblers' Association, the applicant for the registration, but Mr Gill handed to me a document signed by the Secretary of the Ramblers' Association requesting me to refuse to confirm the registration.

I therefore refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
