



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 206/D/114 & 115

In the Matter of Four pieces of land additional to the tracts of land known as Caradon Hill and Fore Down and also known as Caradon Common, St Cleer and Linkinhorne, Caradon D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 2 and 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 205 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No X880 made by C W F White and noted in the Register on 21 March 1972 and Objection No X947 made by J E C and G C L David noted in the Register on 21 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 14 July 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Carne on behalf of Mr & Mrs Daniel, Mr & Mrs Hosken the applicants for Rights under Entry No 9, formerly No 2, having notified me by letter dated 12 July 1975 of the withdrawal of their claim and Mr Barneby the applicant under Entry No 3 not having appeared to support his claim I refuse to confirm Entry Nos 3 and 9 in the Rights Section of the Register.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
