

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 155 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X307 made by St Neot Parish Council and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 29 October 1970. The hearing was attended by Mr V M Carne of Messrs R Hancock and Son, Solicitors of Callington, appeared for the objector St Neots Parish Council and Mr A J Deacon of Messrs Counters, Solicitors of Liskeard, appeared for the Rights Claimants. Mr Carne withdrew his client's objection.

For these reasons I confirm the registration in the Land Section and all the registrations in the Rights Section.

Mr Deacon asked for an Order for Costs against the Objector on the ground that there had been undue delay in withdrawing the objection. I am not satisfied that the delay in this case was such as to merit an Order for Costs and I therefore refuse the application.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
