



In the Matter of Higher Larrick Common, Lezant

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 383 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 628 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill who appeared for the County Council and by the other applicants in person. I heard the application at the same time as the application under Reference No. 206/D/870-871 which related to the same piece of land. I was informed by Mr Gill that all the parties interested were agreed that I should be asked to confirm the applications in the land section and in the rights section, the application for registration as a village green having been withdrawn.

For these reasons I confirm the registration in the Land section and in the Rights section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
