



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.206/D/51

In the Matter of Kenneggy Downs or  
Greenbury Downs, Germoe, Cornwall (No.2).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos.2,3 and 7 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 189 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.X 30 made by Mrs E.K.James and noted in the Register on 23rd February 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 12th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr B.H.Fox, solicitor, on behalf of Mr C.H.Banks and Mrs G.C.Banks, the applicants for the registration at Entry Nos.2 and 3, and by Mr D.W.Pepperell, solicitor, on behalf of Mr J.H.King, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.7. I was informed that the Objector had died.

In the absence of any evidence in support of the Objection I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
