



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/876

In the Matter of Kestle Green St. ThomasDECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.447 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. KL35A made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 16 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lostwithiel on 31 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr Brian Sandercock on behalf of his father Mr L H Sandercock and by Mr D Gill for the County Council.

At the request of both parties I heard this reference together with Reference No. 206/D/879. Mr Sandercock was unable to produce any evidence to establish that the unit was common land.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
