DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL 690 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No X 208A made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 25 June 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Camborne on 6 October 1980. At the hearing Cornwall County Council were represented by Mr D M Gill, and Breage Parish Council were represented by Mr R G Parker one of their members and formerly chairman.

The land ("the Unit Land") in this Register Unit is about $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre or less. The Land Section registration was made in consequence of an application for the registration of a grazing right and rights of turbary, attached to Sea Croft Hotel, Praa Sands over the Unit Land and a very much larger area to the west and the southwest.

Mr Gill said that this larger area is the land in Register Unit No CL 202 of which the registration is now final and that the Unit Land is a small piece of rough land at the entrance to the CL 202 land. Mr Parker said that the Unit Land being at the entrance of the CL 202 land could be regarded as part of it.

In these circumstances, Mr Gill being agreeable to the objection being treated as withdrawn, I confirm the registration without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
