



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 268 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X163A made by Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 19 January 1980.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill who appeared for Cornwall County Council, the objector and informed that he had heard from a representative of the Constantine Parish Council that the application was withdrawn.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
